



## How do I create my website?

---

Now that you've signed up for Appshosting production hosting package, you will need to set up your webpage.

There are two components to your website:

- 1) The static HTML content ,
- 2) The APEX application(s)

Your APEX application login is accessed by the following URL:

- <http://<your URL>/pls/apex>

The initial APEX login authentication is as follows:

*APEX Username:*            admin  
*Password:*                test123

### How to upload files?

Appshosting does not permit FTP access to its servers, due to security implications.

You will need to download "WinSCP", a secure file transfer application which uses the SCP protocol, from the following URL:

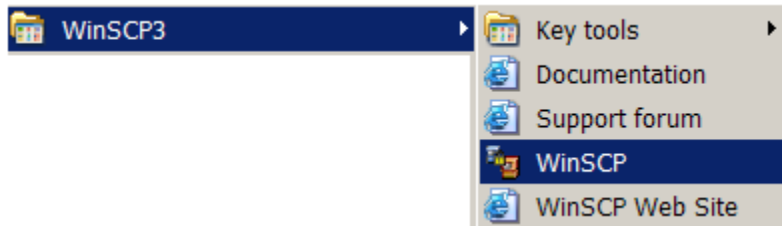

Once you download and install WinSCP, you can create a connection as follows:



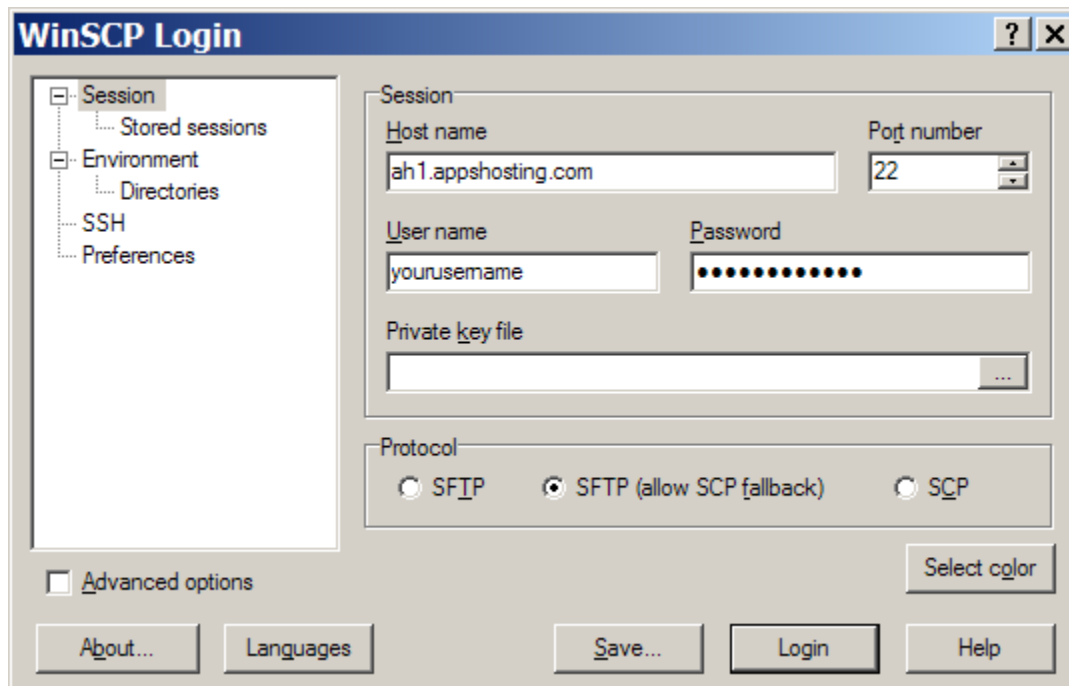
## Step One

Run WinSCP from the start menu:



## Step two

Create a new connection to Appshosting by clicking "new" on the WinSCP screen and providing the following information:



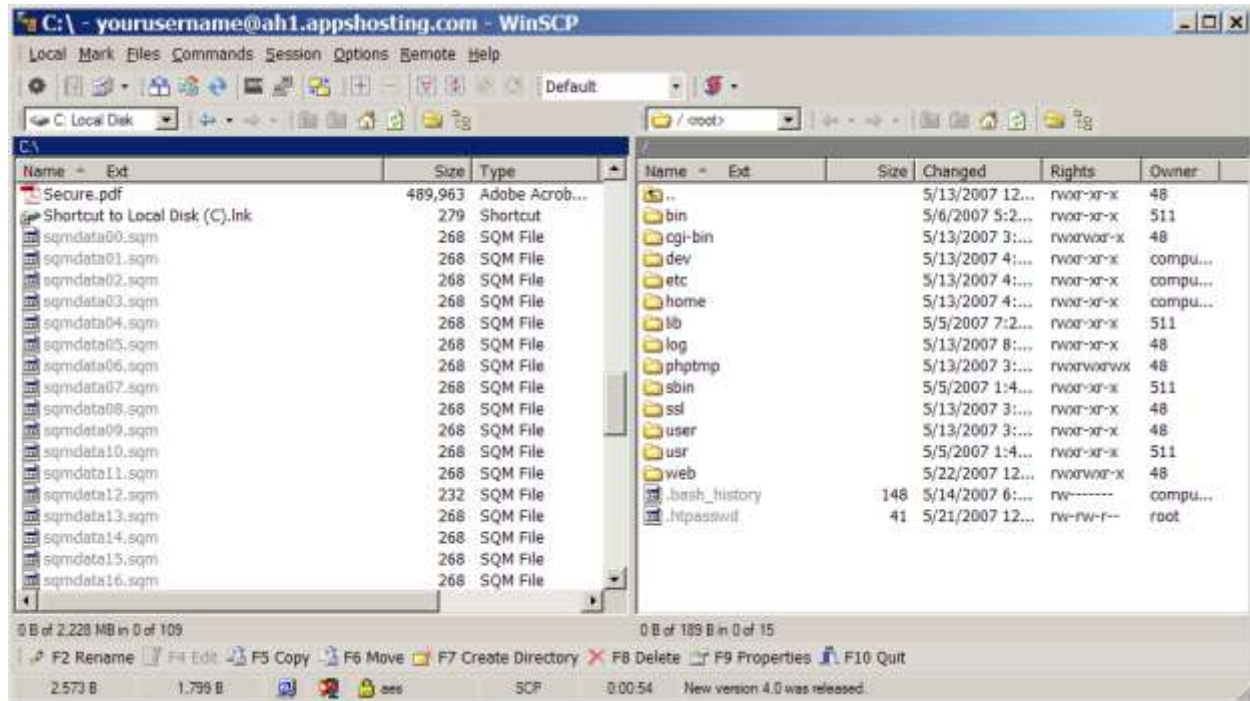
After you're finished entering the hostname. Your user name and password, click save.



## Step three

Connect to AppsHosting using WinSCP by double-clicking on the connection you have created.

Once you're logged in, you should see a screen that resembles the following:



On the left side are the files on your local computer, and on the right side are the files on AppsHosting servers. Note that there is a directory called "Web" on the right side. This is where you need to upload HTML files for your web site. Note that you may also be able to upload CGI programs in the "cgi-bin" directory if your account allows it.

The log files for your website are placed in the "log" directory.

At a minimum, you will need an index.html file as your default web page file.
